

Criteria for Charity Booth Selection

Background

Each year, the Maker's Hand selects one charity to be included (free-of-charge) with the Maker's Hand artisans. The booth will be available for the duration of the event in order to increase awareness and promote the determined charity.

Elements

The charity selected will receive a space within the front area of the venue and a 6 foot table will be supplied to help display relevant materials. In an effort to co-ordinate the overall look of the front room, the design committee may provide additional display elements, or re-arrange the table to co-ordinate with the design/look of the show.

Eligibility

The program must have charitable status, or be affiliated with a charitable organization in order to qualify for the free space. As well, the charity should be prepared to provide written take-away materials (2010 attendance 2,200 + people) as well as having on site personal to promote the cause for the entire duration of the event: Friday 10am - 6pm, Saturday 10am - 6pm, Sunday 10am - 4pm.
